SHELBY MUSEUM TOUR RECAP

Saturday, July 27, 2024 By Andy Mortenson

A group of eight members and two guests met at the Del Taco restaurant at Northfield on the morning of Saturday, July 27th. Following a minor hiccup getting on I-270, we made our way to the Shelby American Museum in Boulder where we were joined by two more club members.

The museum has made some substantial changes since we were there in 2018. They have recently acquired a building across the street from the museum which enables them to display their entire collection. The original building still contains Shelby's British AC predecessor and the 289 and 427 race and street Cobras, the rare Daytona and <u>Willment Coupe</u>, and the GT350 Shelby Mustangs. It also contains the extensive collection of memorabilia, art, race records, period photographs and tributes to the pioneer drivers of the era, and the dramatic histories and life stories of Carroll Shelby.

All the Ford GT's in the collection except one are now displayed across the street. There are about a dozen of them ranging from 1966 to 2023 model years in the second building. Of special interest was the GT40 driven by Ken Miles to a controversial second place finish in the 1966 Le Mans race and the 1968 GT40 which was used as the camera car for the Steve McQueen movie "Le Mans" and is valued at \$11 million.

Thanks to everyone for attending.

In the pictures below, Car #1 is the 1966 Le Mans GT40; Car #23 is the Willment Coupe which is based on the Pete Brock designed Cobra Daytona Coup; Car #40 is the 1968 GT40 camera car in its original Gulf Racing Team colors.



If visiting Breckenridge is not on your schedule, at Hoosier summit, take State Highway 9 back to Fairplay, and your route of choice home. If you want to return to Denver from Breckenridge, take State Highway 9 to Frisco and I70 east to Denver.

The Nissan Heritage Museum in Japan



Hemmings Car Culture

It has long struck me that from the half-decade from 1989-94, that Nissan might have had the most interesting passenger car lineup around. There was the twin-turbo 300ZX, which gave Porsche's 928 some competition for the best GT car at the end of the 20th century. The Silvia and 180SX, known in the States as the 240SX, which were given chassis manners to match their sharp style. The '89 Maxima, the fourdoor sports car, and its junior sibling the Nissan Primera/Infiniti G20 gave families a bit of a thrill. Even cars further down Nissan's food chain, like the lowly Sentra, had the hot SE-R model available. And that was just in the States: overseas had a panoply of machines (from the BE-1/Pao/S-Cargo/Figaro specialty vehicles to the mighty Skyline GT-R) that, if they weren't fast, were still thoughtful and fun. There were always the dull ones—there always are—but there was generally an interesting alternative elsewhere in Nissan's lineup where many other manufacturers, Japanese or otherwise, simply shrugged. Blame it on the bubble economy or whatever you want, but to my eyes, Nissan was spreading it out in all directions and absolutely killing it in route.

And so when visiting Yokohama a while back, the opportunity to visit Nissan's Heritage Museum proved irresistible. The dedicated facility is located at Zama, in greater Yokohama. Tours last 90 minutes, and (when I went) required an online reservation on a Japanese-only page. The tour itself was conducted in Japanese, although cards near each car were bilingual English and Japanese shows you pictures of everything, but it does not display the scope of what you see when you walk in. It is, initially, overwhelming. Often, museums will gather items in themes in a variety of cordoned-off spaces. Maybe they'll arrange by decade, or body style, or street versus competition. Not here. Hundreds of cars are here in one big warehouse space. Other than chronology (and a few other groupings—a gaggle of Skylines here, a line of Zs there) there are really two main sections: street cars and race cars. The competition veterans are generally arranged by type—all of the rally cars against one wall, all of the Super Silhouette cars against another, all of the Group C prototype cars in an aisle together. Got a hankering to see the proposed Can-Am racer the R382? They've got a couple. There's no effort to shoehorn some new product in there—save for a GT-R we saw that was autographed by sprinter Usain Bolt. There's barely even a gift shop. There are other surprises inside. A number of fairly pedestrian street cars are cordoned off with stanchions that feel like they're filled with concrete (I moved a couple to try and get better photos but good grief, I didn't bring my workout clothes) ... but their legendary race cars, race winners from all around the globe, were completely accessible. Maybe the thinking was, if a 300-kilometer race didn't break them, neither could a dopey gaijin tourist?

Winnowing down my selection to just nine cars took longer than it took me to write these up; there's so much more that isn't even touched on here. The Nissan Heritage Museum needs way more than just the allotted 90 minutes to see and absorb. See the link below for the full article, including the nine cars selected.
